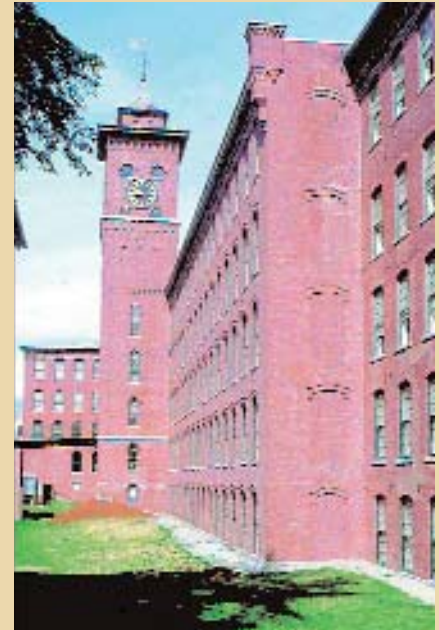


# Housing and Real Estate

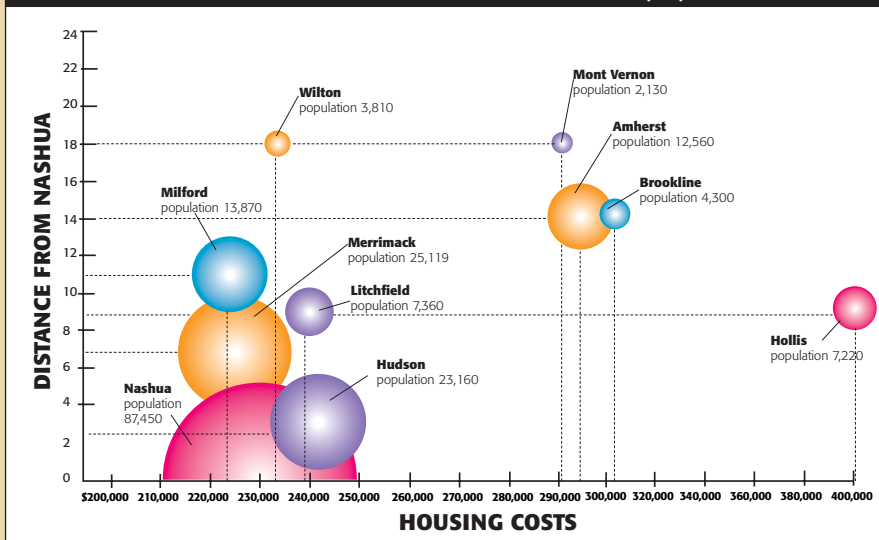
Clocktower Place historic apartment building along the Nashua River

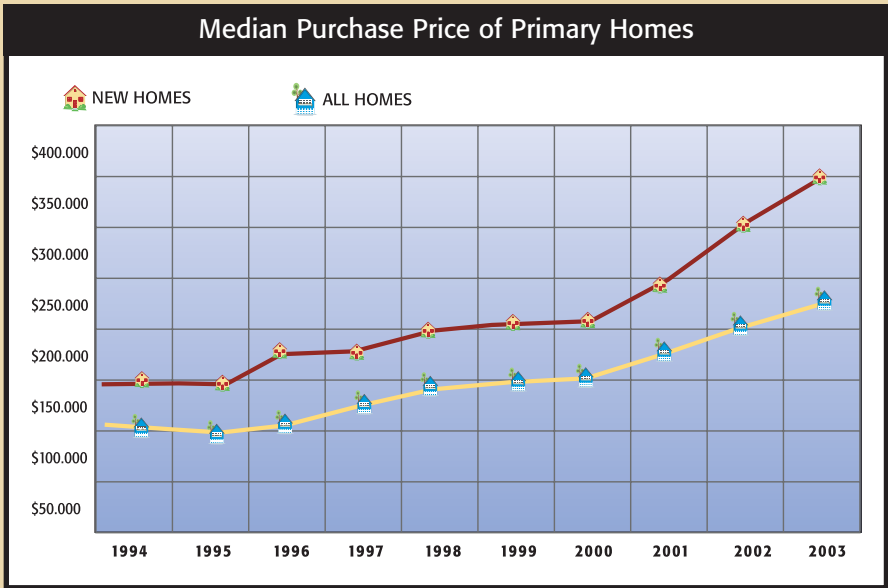
The size of the bubbles roughly indicates the population of the particular town. The exact numbers are also included for reference purposes

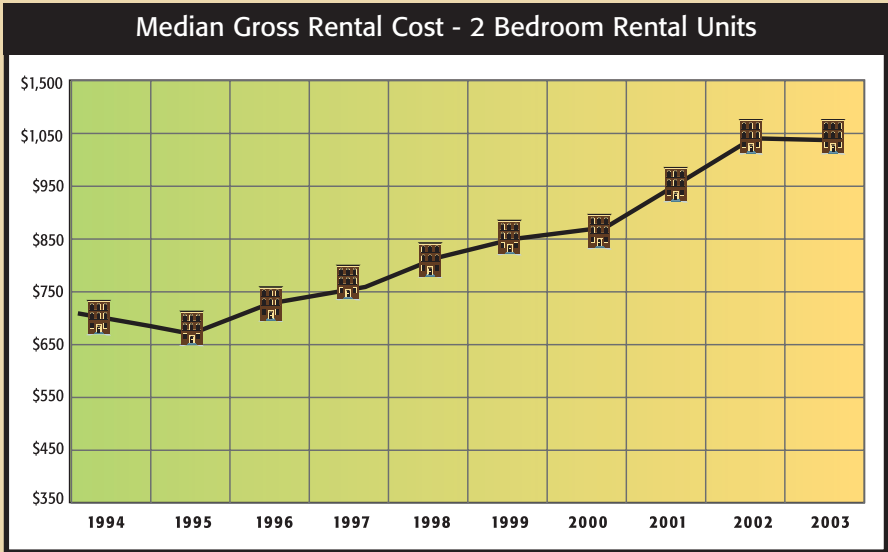
