Application Procedures & Criteria for Selection

WHO SHOULD APPLY? LGN seeks to identify emerging leaders in the Greater Nashua area that outwardly indicate a strong desire to assume a leadership role within the organization and in the community. Classes will be limited in size. Individuals will be selected based upon individual characteristics balanced with a desire to create a class that will present a diverse and challenging group of participants.

HOW TO APPLY: All individuals interested must complete the enclosed program application. Applications must be received no later than Friday, July 15, 2010, in order to be considered.

SELECTION: A class will include 20-25 participants selected after review of applications and interviews. Emphasis will be placed on individual qualifications, balanced by a need to create a diverse and stimulating group. Selections will be made by August 5, 2011.

Candidates must:

1. Be willing to commit time and energy.
(by attending a minimum of 80% of class sessions)
2. Possesses an occupational commitment to remain within the Greater Nashua area through the course of the program.
3. Hold a leadership/management position within their organization or within the community.

TUITION & CONTRACT: Tuition for LGN is \$1000 and covers all sessions, supportive materials, and meals. This amount must be paid largely in part by a financial sponsor, typically the applicant's employer or other sponsoring organization. The applicant is asked to contribute \$100 of the fee to demonstrate his/her personal commitment to the program. Limited financial aid is available based on need and qualifications. Final payment will be due September 1, 2011. All payments are non-refundable. NO individual may attend the initial session unless payment has been made in full.

A letter of commitment is included in the application and must be signed by the applicant and applicant's employer in order to be considered.

CANDIDATES NOT SELECTED are invited to reapply for a subsequent program.
