Rotary Club of Nashua West Presents 13 Local Charities with Grants from Funds Raised at Ribfest

Nashua, N.H. – The Rotary Club of Nashua West recognized 13 local nonprofit organizations on Nov. 24 with grants from the funds raised at its Rotary Rock'n Ribfest, the Club's major annual fundraiser, which took place in June.

The Club presented grants to the American Legion Band, Boys & Girls Club of Greater Nashua, Granite State Children's Alliance, Girl Scouts of the Green and White Mountains, Home Health & Hospice Care, Leukemia & Lymphoma Society, Currier Museum of Art, Nashua Chamber Orchestra, Nashua River Watershed Association, Nashua Special Olympics, Rivier Institute for Senior Education, Salvation Army of Nashua, and United Way of Greater Nashua. These organizations represent one third of the recipients of grants from Ribfest; the Club will present the rest of the recipients with their grants in February and May 2016.

The final check from this initial round of grants went toward the Club's own program to provide students with hats and mittens free of charge, which fulfilled all the needs in the City of Nashua this year.

The Rotary Club of Nashua West is a group of like-minded professionals dedicated to serving others less fortunate than themselves. The Club's membership includes over 90 business owners, executives and professionals from the Nashua area.
