NCC and FAA host ‘Walk in My Boots’ for area high schoolers

Nashua, N.H. May 17, 2016- Nashua Community College (NCC) in partnership with the Federal Aviation Administration will host an aviation job shadow day, “Walk in My Boots,” on Tuesday, May 24 at 9 a.m. Students from the college’s Aviation Technology associate degree program will provide live demonstrations of current projects, including riveting and engine work for 13 high school students from Nashua North High School.

According to Bob Donadio of the college’s Aviation Technology Department, the college and the FAA have partnered together for many years. The FAA uses its own resources to meet with potential candidates and arrange for the host school to provide transportation.

“Current aviation students enrolled in the program work with the high schoolers all day on projects pertaining to aviation maintenance,” said Donadio. “Both groups of students are learning and having fun all at once. It’s opportune exposure to the world of aviation maintenance, a field of work which may very well catch their interests.”
