



How meaningful is SBIR in New Hampshire? For the last three years, there was an **average of 75 grant awards for \$35 million in grant funding** for proof of concept and prototype development, awarded to 20-30 companies each year. Some companies receive multiple awards, others receive one or two every few years – it all depends on what the company does.

Any company that does innovative research or that produces a precision, technical or similar product or service that can be adapted to meet other needs could benefit from learning more about SBIR, and this opportunity may not recur for many years.

The SBIR Road Tour is coming to Manchester, NH on Thursday, August 23, 2018, to convey the non-dilutive technology funding opportunity provided through the Small Business Innovation Research (SBIR) and Small Business Technology Transfer (STTR) programs.

On August 23, individual program managers from as many as 11 participating agencies representing \$2.5 billion in early stage funding will participate in a one day event alongside technology entrepreneurs and state innovation ecosystem members.
