



Application Procedure and Criteria for Selection

WHAT IS LEADERSHIP GREATER NASHUA? LGN was founded in 1995 by a group of local business and community leaders who began asking, "Today, we know each other, and we know who we would need to bring to the table to help our community capitalize on an opportunity or overcome a crisis. Who will take our place in 25 years? Who will head our non-profit and civic organizations? Who will serve on those Boards? Do they know each other? Do they know our community?"

From those questions came a program designed to educate and connect emerging leaders through an in-depth look at greater Nashua's economic, civic and government sectors, and the design and implementation of a class project. Since 1995, over 500 individuals have graduated from LGN, enriching the fabric of our community, strengthening our resilience and leading for our future.

WHO SHOULD APPLY? The Chamber seeks emerging leaders with a strong desire to build their connections within the region so they may successfully assume leadership roles within their organization(s) and in their community. LGN specifically encourages those in ethnically and culturally diverse sectors in the Greater Nashua area to consider applying.

HOW TO APPLY: All individuals interested must complete the 2019-2020 Leadership Greater Nashua application. Applications must be received no later than Thursday, July 18, 2019.

SELECTION: 20-25 class members will be selected based upon individual qualifications, balanced with a desire to create a diverse and stimulating class.

Candidates must be willing to commit time and energy to LGN, including attending and actively participating in the opening retreat, each monthly class, and any additional time outside of session days needed for the Class Project. These individuals will hold or aspire to a leadership / management position within their organization and/or within the Greater Nashua community, with demonstrated existing leadership skills.

Applicants not selected in a given year are invited to reapply for a subsequent program.

TUITION and PROGRAM COMMITMENT: Tuition for LGN is \$1,250; a payment plan option is available. Limited financial aid is available based on need and qualifications. All payments are nonrefundable. No individual may attend the initial session unless payment has been made (in full or via an approved monthly installment plan).
