

Greater Nashua Chamber of Commerce 2021 Citizen of the Year Nomination Form



The **Citizen of the Year Award** honors an individual of local prominence who has made significant contributions to the betterment of life in the Greater Nashua area.

Nomination Criteria

- A person who continually volunteers his or her time, dedication and talents to **Greater Nashua** and its citizens to make it a great place to live, work, play and learn.
- Consideration will be given for leadership and performance across multiple areas of community service over a period of years. While leadership within his/her company is important, the individual's influence and impact should reach beyond their employment.
- The individual recognized does not have to be a member of the Greater Nashua Chamber of Commerce or the business community. They may serve on service, school, church, and/or community committees. They may be an individual from any walk of life, and there are no requirements or restrictions with regard to gender, race, religion, sexual orientation, or ethnic background.
- A person with demonstrated honesty and integrity who has shown a willingness to work with other Greater Nashua residents, who is enthusiastic about the town and its citizens, and who works towards the betterment of the community.

Nomination Procedures and Rules

- Complete and submit this form, along with a brief bio of the nominee, answers to the questions on the reverse side of this form and any letters of recommendation, **no later than September 10, 2021**. Nominations may be mailed or hand delivered to the Greater Nashua Chamber of Commerce at 60 Main Street, Suite 200, Nashua, NH, 03060, or can be emailed to the Chamber at admin@NashuaChamber.com.
- Evaluation of the nominees will be based primarily upon the information submitted in the nomination form; however, Review Committee members' personal knowledge of the nominees will also be considered.
- If a candidate is not selected this year, the individual can be nominated in future years; however, a new nomination form must be submitted for each year.
- Past Citizen of the Year award winners are not eligible for subsequent nominations. Posthumous nominations are ineligible.
- All nominations will be kept confidential.
